



FAQ - Frequently Asked Questions

1) Can my child have a tryout at SC Frankfurt 1880 Rugby?

Yes, however, prior contact is required so that the coach(es) can adjust to the child/children's visit. There may also be spontaneous changes to the training time and location. Therefore, always contact the team manager of the respective youth team first. The contact details of the team managers can either be found on the website or can be obtained from the secretary's office via e-mail: sekretariat@sc1880.de.

2) What clothes should my child bring for the first training session?

For the first training session, a T-shirt, sports shorts and sports shoes are sufficient for a start. We recommend clothes that don't mind getting dirty or broken. The basic requirement for rugby is a gumshield, which is mandatory from U8 training onwards.

4) Does my child have to become a member of SC Frankfurt 1880 immediately?

No, every child has the opportunity to try out training first. The child is welcome to try out three to four training sessions free of charge. If the child's interest and passion for rugby is awakened, we will of course be happy to welcome the child as a new member.

5) Can my child take part in the rugby camps if he/she is not a club member?

Unfortunately, for insurance reasons, participation in the Rugby Camps during the Hessian spring, summer and autumn holidays is only possible if he/she becomes a club member.

6) How do I receive information about training?

You will receive more information about training times, dates etc. from the team managers of the respective children's and youth teams. They will also keep you up to date with all the important news about rugby at SC Frankfurt 1880 by e-mail.

7) How does the team change of my child to the next age group take place?

The children change age groups automatically after the summer holidays. The criterion is the year of birth of the children.

Minis: 3 to 6 years

U8: the oldest admitted birth cohort will be 7 years old in the year of the start of the season.

U10: the oldest eligible cohort will be 9 years old in the year of the start of the season.

U12: the oldest eligible cohort will be 11 years old in the year of the start of the season.

U14: the oldest eligible cohort will be 13 years old in the year of the start of the season.

U16: the oldest eligible cohort will be 15 years old in the year of the start of the season.

U18: the oldest eligible cohort will be 17 years old in the year of the start of the season.



8) What is the role of the “Förderverein”?

The “Förderverein Rugbyjugend SC 1880” is a Supporters' Association and is financed by donations and fundraising activities. It supports the youth work at the club, for example with subsidies for team trips or individual help if a family cannot afford all the costs.
